

Featured Class Descriptions



\$200 Halley Barrett Sporthorses Open Equitation Challenge 2'/2'6"/3' (Friday) Presented by: Halley Barrett Sporthorses Entry Fee: \$35

This class is open to all horse/pony and rider combinations, but each rider and horse may only be entered once. The course will be an equitation style round over a mixture of both hunter and jumper style jumps. There will be no combination. The first round will be judged and a score will be announced immediately following the round. The top 4 or 6 riders (judges discretion) with the highest first round scores will be invited back for a work off, either on the flat or over fences, which will determine the final standings. Prize money will be distributed as follows: 1st: \$100, 2nd: \$50, 3rd: \$35, 4th: \$15. This class will be run as class number 150.

\$200 Gamboa Veterinarian Services Gambler's Choice Presented by: Gamboa Veterinarian Services Entry Fee: \$35


This class is open to all horse/pony and rider combinations. Riders may compete multiple horses in this class. Each fence will carry a point value. Each rider will decide their own path around the course, but can only jump a fence twice, either direction, and only if it's still standing correctly. Every rider must start with the same first jump (to break the timer). Each rider will have one minute to complete their course. The tone will sound at 60 seconds to end the ride, after which the rider must break the "finish" timer before going on to the joker jump (if the rider wants to do the joker jump). The rider with the highest points collected during their course will win. The time recorded will be used in the event of ties, in order to break ties. No points are given for a jump with a "knockdown", or for a jump taken after the 60 seconds expires. Two (2) refusals result in elimination. The time recorded will be used in the event of ties, in order to break ties. Once the allotted time has ended (60 seconds) and buzzer has sounded, each rider has the opportunity to immediately proceed to jump the Joker fence - with the hope of gaining more points or the risk losing those points (value of the joker jump) with a knockdown.

This class will be ridden at the end of each division, after all classes in the division are complete (no back to back with the Gambler' Choice class). The card will stay open through all jumper classes. Rider's may choose to jump at any height. Jumps will not be lowered once they have been raised. Prize money will be distributed as follows: 1st: \$100, 2nd: \$50, 3rd: \$35, 4th: \$15. This class will be run as class number 151.

Featured Class Descriptions



\$200 B Physical Therapy Hunt and Go Derby 2'/2'6"/3' Presented by: B Physical Therapy Entry Fee: \$35

This class is open to all horse/pony and rider combinations. Rider's may compete multiple horses, but the maximum number of horses one rider can compete is three (3). The course will be held over hunter style jumps and the course will consist of 12-16 jumps. The course will not include a combination. The first half of the course will count as the classic phase and the second half of the course will count as the handy phase. The entire course will be jumped at one time. The judge may award up to 4 handy points in the second phase. The judge will give a separate score for phase one (1) and phase (2) and the score's from both pages will be combined. The horse and rider combination with the highest combined score will win. In the event of a tie, the second (2) phase score will be the tie breaking score. The judge will also award a winner of the **B Physical Therapy Style of Riding Award**. Prize money will be distributed as follows: 1st: \$100, 2nd: \$50, 3rd: \$35, 4th: \$15. This class will be run as class number 152

\$200 Golden Gate Equestrian All in One Jumper Classic (Sunday) Presented By: Golden Gate Equestrian Entry Fee: \$35

Open to all horse/pony and rider combinations. The All in One jumper classic is not an additional class, the score from your II 2b jumper round will count for this classic. Horse/pony and rider combinations that are competing in multiple divisions must declare which division they would like to count for the All In One before they enter the ring. A handicap on time is deducted from your jump off round as follows: 2' will receive no time deduction, 2'3" will receive a 1 second time deduction, 2'6" will receive a 2 second time deduction, and 3'3" will receive a 3 second time deduction. The rider with the fastest clear jump off round will be the winner. For riders who do not make the jump off the same deduction scale will be made for their first round time and their faults will be noted. At the concussion of all jumper divisions, this class will be awarded. Prize money will be distributed as follows: 1st: \$100, 2nd: \$50, 3rd: \$35, 4th: \$15. This class will be run as class number 153.

\$200 Halley Barrett Sporthorses Hunter Classic Presented by Halley Barrett Sporthorses Entry Fee: \$35

This classic is open to all horse/pony and rider combinations. This is not an additional class, the second round score from your hunter division will count for this classic. Horse and rider combinations competing in multiple divisions must declare which division they would like to count before entering the ring. Once all hunter divisions for the day have concluded, the class will be pinned. Prize money will be distributed as follows: 1st: \$100, 2nd: \$50, 3rd: \$35, 4th: \$15. This class will be run as class number 154.








Rules & Regulations



Governing Body — This show shall be run in accordance with USEF rules, except where GOHJA rules dictate otherwise.

Headgear — Protective A.S.T.M./S.E.I approved Headgear is mandatory at all times when mounted. Chin straps must be snug.

Judging — Classes will be judged on performance and soundness unless otherwise noted.

Attire — Proper attire required in all classes. Jackets my be waived at the discretion of Show Management based on weather conditions.

Schooling — All schooling will be confined to designated areas. Schooling in the show rings will be limited to

specific times. See class schedule for times.

Classes — Show Management reserves the right to combine or cancel any class(es) with the appropriate notification.

The 3-Minute Rule — This will be used as required to prevent unnecessary show delays and will be strictly enforced. No ring will "hold" for more than 30 min. for a conflict.

Time Management — Trainer conflicts will not be allowed for flat classes.

Entries — All entries must be listed on an entry form. The Secretary will not issue a number until the entry form is signed. All horses and riders entering the show rings or the schooling rings must be entered, including those not showing. All horses and riders, on the show grounds must be registered with the Secretary.

Add/Scratch — When adding or scratching a class, fill out an Add/Scratch Form in the Secretary's office. No Add/Scratchs at the gate.

Rider Changes — Rider changes must be recorded with the Secretary's office.

Class Questions — Complete class specifications are available in the GOHJA Rule Book. If one is not available to you, contact the Steward prior to the start of the show if you have any questions.

Jogs — Soundness will be considered, but entries will not jog.

Flat Classes — No martingales permitted in any flat class.

Prizes — Ribbons will be awarded for first through sixth place in all classes. All entrants in Leadline and Walk-Trot will receive ribbons.

Year End — Points toward year-end awards will only be awarded to GOHJA members and/or GOHJA recorded horses/ponies.

Champion/Reserve — Points toward show-day Division Champion and division Reserve Champion will be awarded to

the top six placings in each class, except Training Hunter and Leadline for all divisions.

Training Hunter — Entries for Training Hunter must pre-enter or complete an Add/Scratch Form at the Secretary's office and give to in-gate person before entering show ring.

Back Numbers — A current show # must be worn to enter warm-up or show ring.

Class Descriptions



All hunter divisions have two jump classes and an under saddle class. Horses will walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring. Under saddle classes allow not more than 8 to hand gallop at one time. No hand gallop in the following hunter divisions: Modified Children's, Modified Adult, Children's, Schooling, Low and Green. No martingales in any hunter flat classes.

WALK-TROT: Equitation, Pleasure, and Hunter Hack. Open to riders in the appropriate age group who have not cantered at a GOHJA show. Walk and trot both ways of the ring. The Hunter Hack is judged as an u/s class. After hacking all will trot two poles.

SHORT-STIRRUP HUNTER: Open to riders 12 & under, who have not jumped over 18" at a GOHJA or USEF show. Fences not to exceed 18". Walk, trot, and canter, both ways of the ring.

LONG-STIRRUP HUNTER: Open to amateur riders 13 & over. Other specifications same as Short Stirrup. Riders wishing to reinstate eligibility for this division should contact the Hearings Committee.

LOW HUNTER: Open to horses and ponies. Fences 2'6" or 2'3" (No in & out)

SCHOOLING HUNTER: Open to horses and ponies. Fences 2'9" or 3'3".

GREEN HUNTER: 1st year horses fences 2'9", 2nd year horses fences 3' judged as one division, U/S combined.

OPEN HUNTER: Fences 3' or 2'9" maximum.

CHILDREN'S PONY HUNTER: Open to Junior riders only on ponies. May cross enter where eligible. Small/medium/large ponies designate fence height 2' or 2'6". No in and out and lines will not be adjusted.

LOW CHILDREN'S HUNTER: Open to Junior riders on horses; 2'6" fence height. Horse/Rider combination may not cross enter into High Children's or Modified at the same show.

HIGH CHILDREN'S HUNTER: Open to Junior riders on horses; 3'0" or 2'9" fence height. Horse/Rider combination may not cross enter into Low Children's or Modified at the same show.

LOW ADULT HUNTER: Open to Amateur riders on horses or ponies; 2'6" fence height. Horse/Rider combination may not cross enter into High Adult or Modified at the same show.

HIGH ADULT HUNTER: Open to Amateur riders on horses or ponies; 2'9" or 3'0" fence height. Horse/Rider combination may not cross enter into Low Adult or Modified at the same show.

MODIFIED HUNTER: Open to Junior or Amateur riders on horses or ponies; 2'3" fence height. Horse/Rider combination may not cross enter into High Children's, Low Children's, High Adult, or Low Adult at the same show.

CROSS RAIL HUNTER: Open to all riders on horses or ponies; 15" fence height. May trot or canter. Horse/Rider combination may not cross enter into any class where fence heights exceed 2'0". Note that riders may cross enter into Short or Long Stirrups if eligible, but Walk Trot riders lose their W/T eligibility by entering these jump classes.

BEGINNER RIDER HUNTER: Open to Junior and Amateur riders. Not to have jumped over 2'3" in any GOHJA or USEF show. May cross enter into GOHJA over fences that are 2' and 2'3" in fence height.. Fence height 2'. Entrants may ride more than one horse.

BABY GREEN HUNTER: Open to horses and ponies in their first and second year of showing 2' fence height. Can cross enter 2'3" divisions.

Class Descriptions



CROSS RAIL WALK-TROT HUNTER: Same as Cross Rail Hunter, except no canter. May only cross enter into Walk-Trot Division.

TRAINING HUNTER: To be offered immediately before each division at the fence height for that division. May only be ridden once per horse/pony per ring. To be numerically scored by the judge as a hunter over fences round. Entries scoring between 70 and 75 receive a red ribbon and entries scoring greater than 75 receive a blue ribbon. Does not count toward any year-end or hi-point awards.

ADULT MEDAL: Open to Amateur GOHJA members 18 and over. Fences 2'6"/2'9" or 3', USEF test 1-18. Top 4 must test additionally.

JUNIOR MEDAL: Open to Junior GOHJA members 17 and under. Fences 2'6"/ 2'9" or 3', USEF tests 1-8. Top 4 must test additionally.

PONY MEDAL: Open to Junior members on ponies only. No in & out. USEF age restrictions apply. Rider may not cross enter into any other Medal at the same show. Pony must have USEF or GOHJA measurement card. Original course to contain at least two tests—USEF tests 1-8—no additional testing. Fence heights 2'0" or 2'6".

OPEN EQUITATION MEDAL: 2'3" & 2': riders may not cross enter into any other GOHJA medals at same show.

PONY EQUITATION: Fences 2'/2'6": no in and out. Junior Equitation 2'6"/2'9"/3'. Adult: fences 2'6"/2'9"/3', amateur to ride

OPEN EQUITATION: Open to Junior and Amateur riders any age. Choice of fence height 2' or 2'3", no on & out. Rider may not cross enter into any other age group equitation class.

CROSS RAIL EQUITATION: Open to Junior or Amateur riders on horses or ponies 15" fence height.

CROSS RAIL WALK-TROT EQUITATION: Same as above except no canter. May only cross enter into Walk-Trot. Canter to be penalized.

BEGINNER RIDER EQUITATION: Open to Junior and Amateurs of any age. May cross enter into any other GOHJA over fences that are 2' or 2'3". Rider may not have jumped over 2'3" at GOHJA or USEF shows. Fences 2'

PUDDLE JUMPER: Open to Junior and Senior riders. Designed to be a beginner jumper division. Fences 2'/2'3" with a spread maximum of 2'.

OPEN JUMPER: LEVEL 0: Fences 2'6" or 2'9", spreads not to exceed 2'6".

LEVEL 1: Fences 3' or 3'3", spreads 3' to 3'3".

CHILDREN/ADULT AMATEUR JUMPER: Fences 3', spreads not to exceed 3'.

TIP Hunter:

Must have TIP# from the Jockey Club Fence height to be choice of 2'3",2'6",2'9"

Two classes over fences with a minimum of 7 jumps. Under saddle-w,t,c- no hand gallop, no martingale.
